Why do a WCL Minor?

Show prospective employers you are culturally competent
Enjoy courses that challenge and expand your perspectives

Choose classes from World Literature, History, History of Art, Philosophy, and Religious Studies

All course materials are in English translation

Five courses total, two can be double counted

No second language required, but one 200 level or above FLx language class can be included

For STEM students, both Humanities courses can be double counted for major and minor

For CHASS students up to two courses including a language course can be double counted for major and minor
